- Registration forms for provisional admission will be issued from the school counter on payment of Rs. 500/- from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm, on all working days, from 05.03.2021 to 31.03.2021. The forms can be submitted at the school counter during the above mentioned time period.
- The candidates can register online through the school website www.davrkl.org. Please go through the process of online registration and the Information Brochure carefully before filling up the form.
- Date of Aptitude test for provisional Admission : 4th April 2021
- Examination centre: DAV Public School, Basanti Colony, Rourkela
- Examination Timing: 9.00 am to 11.00 am (For Science stream)
11.30 am to 1.30 am (For Commerce stream)
- Reporting time : 30 min. before examination.
- **Eligibility criteria for appearing in the test:-**
 - a) **Science-** Candidate must be an aspirant of class- X Board examination conducted by CBSE/ ICSE/BSE (Odisha) / Any other state board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 75% in aggregate and 75% in both Maths and Science in class -X Board exam may apply.
 - b) **Commerce-** Candidate must be an aspirant of class- X Board examination conducted by CBSE/ ICSE/BSE (Odisha) / Any other state board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 60% in aggregate in Class-X Board Exam may apply.
- Declaration of the result of Aptitude Test : 6th April 2021
- Schedule of provisional Admission: 7th April to 16th April 2021 on all working days (Details of Admission procedure will be notified on the date of declaration of result.
- Provisional Admission shall be allowed purely on merit of Aptitude Test. However admission will be confirmed after declaration of respective Board Examination result and securing desired % of marks.
- Mere registration doesn't confer right on any one for taking provisional admission.

Combination-4 : English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Geography.
Combination-5 : English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Physical Education.

Optional Subjects (Commerce Stream):

- Combination-1 : English, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics
Combination-2 : English, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Computer Sc.
Combination-3 : English, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Geography
Combination-4 : English, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Physical Education

Sixth Optional Subject (Science & Commerce Stream):

1. Music - Hindustani Vocal 2. Painting 3. Physical Education

Candidates can choose any one of the above subjects as Sixth Optional.

Note : Candidates should choose their optional subjects carefully.

Eligibility criteria to appear in the Aptitude Test for Class XI (2021)

1. Science :- Candidate must be an aspirant of Class – X Board Examination conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha) / Any State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 75% in aggregate and 75% in both Maths and Science in Class X Board Exam may apply.
2. Commerce :- Candidate must be an aspirant of Class – X Board Examination conducted by CBSE / ICSE / BSE (Odisha) / Any State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 60% in aggregate in Class X Board Exam may apply.

Procedure for admission to Class XI (2021)

1. He / She will take admission form from the school counter on payment of Rs. 500/- and deposit the duly filled- up form in school latest by 1 pm on 31.03.2021.
2. Incomplete forms in any respect will be rejected.
3. A photo copy of the money receipt of the admission form must be deposited along with the admission form.
4. The candidates can register online through the school website www.davrkl.org. Please go through the process of online registration and the information sheet carefully before filling up the form.
 - a) Arrange the soft copy of the photographs of the candidate, father and mother in JPG file less than 1MB each.
 - b) Open the website www.davrkl.org and click on Online Admission Link for Std. XI (Session 2021 – 22). Enter parent's email-id and mobile no. and press GENERATE CODE button. A password will be sent to the above email-id & mobile no. In LOGIN INFORMATION screen, enter the email-id and password and click on PROCEED button to go to next page. Enter the information as asked for. Click the checkbox for the Declaration and click on Submit button.
 - c) After final submission of the registration form the payment gateway will open and after paying the non refundable registration charge of Rs. 500/- successfully take the printout of the registration form and submit to the school on the date of Aptitude Test.
5. The list of eligible candidates for Aptitude Test will be available on our school website (www.davrkl.org) at 3.00 pm on 02.04.2021 (Friday). Serial Number allotted in the list will be treated as the Roll No. for the Aptitude Test.
6. The Aptitude Test will be held on 04.04.2021 (Sunday) from 9.00 am to 11.00 am for Science and 11 : 30 am to 1: 30 pm for Commerce. Candidates are required to report at the venue 30 mins. before the commencement of the test.
7. Candidates must bring their Aptitude Test Admit cards for identity proof and the hard copy of registration form duly signed by parents. (In case of online submission of form.)





Details of the Aptitude Test

1. The test will be of 2 hours duration.
2. The test is of 200 marks with 50 questions of multiple choice.
3. Each correct answer will carry 4 marks and 1 mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
4. Evaluation will be done as per the Marking scheme prepared by the subject experts of the school.

Courses of study for Aptitude Test (For Science):

- 1) Mathematics : Number system, Polynomials, Pair of linear equations in two variables, Arithmetic Progression, Quadratic equations, Co-ordinate Geometry, Trigonometry, Triangles, Circles, Probability and Statistics.
- 2) Physics : Electricity, Light and Magnetic effect of current.
- 3) Chemistry : Acid, Base & Salt, Atoms & Molecules, Periodic Classification, Chemical reactions and equations.
- 4) Biology: Life Processes, How do organisms reproduce, Heredity and Natural Resources.

- 3) Mathematics : Linear Equation of Two Variables, Statistics & Probability, Quadratic Equations, Arithmetic Progression, Polynomials, Trigonometric Identities and Co- ordinate Geometry.
