

Eligibility criteria to appear in the Aptitude Test for Class XI (2025)

- 1. Science:-Candidate must be an aspirant of Class—X Board Examination conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha)/ Any State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 80% in aggregate and 80 % in both Maths and Science in Class X Board Exam can apply.
- 2. Commerce & Humanities:-Candidate must be an aspirant of Class—X Board Examination conducted by CBSE / ICSE /BSE (Odisha)/ Any State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 70 % & 60 % in aggregate for Commerce & Humanities respectively in Class X Board Exam can apply.

Procedure for admission to Class-XI (2025)

- 1. He/She can take admission form from the school counter on payment of Rs.1000/- and deposit the duly filled-up form in school latest by 1 p.m. on **6 February 2025 (Thursday)**.
- 2. Incomplete forms in any respect will be rejected.
- 3. Money receipt of the admission form must be deposited along with the admission form.
- 4. A photo copy of the Admit Card of the Board Exam 2024-25 will be submitted at the time of provisional admission.
- 5. The candidates can register online through the school website www.davrkl.org. Please go through the process of online registration and the information sheet carefully before filling up the form.
- a. Arrange the softcopy of the photographs of the candidate, father and mother in JPG file less than 1MB each.
- b. Open the website www.davrkl.org and click on Online Admission Link for Std. XI (Session 2025 26). Enter parent's email-id and mobile no. and press GENERATE CODE button. A password will be sent to the above email- id & mobile no. In LOGIN INFORMATION screen, enter the email-id and password and click on PROCEED button to go to next page. Enter the information asked for. Click the checkbox for the Declaration and click on Submit button.
- c. After final submission of the registration form, the payment gateway will open and after paying the non refundable registration charge of Rs.1000/- successfully, take the print out of the registration form and submit to the school on the date of Aptitude Test.
- 6. The list of eligible candidates for Aptitude Test will be available on our school website (www.davrkl.org) at 1.00 p.m. on **08 February 2025 (Saturday)**. Serial Number allotted in the list will be treated as the Roll No. for the Aptitude Test.
- 7. The Aptitude Test will be held on **09 February 2025 (Sunday)** from 9.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. for Science Commerce & Humanities. Candidates are required to report at the venue 30 mins. before the commencement of the test.
- 8. Candidates must bring their Aptitude Test Admit cards for identity proof and the hard copy of registration form duly signed by parents.(In case of online submission of form.).

Details of the Aptitude Test:

- 1. The test will be of 2 hour duration.
- 2. The test is of **200** marks with **100** questions for Science, Commerce & Humanities.
- 3. The questions will be MCQ type in OMR mode.

- 2) Physics: Electricity, Human eye and its defects, Magnetic effect of electric current, Light (reflection & refraction)
- 3) <u>Chemistry</u>: Acid, Base & Salt, Metal & Non-Metal, Carbon and its compound, Chemical reactions and equations, Atoms and molecules, structure of atom.
- 4) Biology: Life Processes, How do organisms reproduce, Heredity, Our environment, The fundamental unit of life, Control and Coordination

- ➤ Eligibility Criteria for appearing in the Test:
 - a) Science Candidate must be an aspirant of Class-X Board Examination 2025 conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha)/ Any other State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 80% in aggregate and 80% in both Maths & Science in class-X Board exam can apply.
- Commerce & Humanities- Candidate must be an aspirant of Class-X Board Examination- 2025 conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha)/ Any other State Board. The candidate expecting to secure at least 70% & 60 % in aggregate for Commerce & Humanities respectively in class-X Board exam can apply.
- > Declaration of the Result of Aptitude Test: 12.02.2025.
- Schedule of Provisional Admission: 20.02.2025 to 28.02.2025 on all working days (Details of Admission procedure will be notified on the date of declaration of result).
- ➤ Provisional Admission shall be allowed purely on merit of Aptitude Test. However admission will be confirmed after declaration of respective Board Examination result and securing desired % of Mark.
- Mere registration doesn't confer right on any one for taking provisional admission.
