- Eligibility Criteria for appearing in the Test:

**Science** – The candidate expecting to secure at least 80% in aggregate and 80% in both Maths & Science in class-X Board exam 2025-26 to be conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha)/ Any State Board can apply.

**Commerce & Humanities**– The candidate expecting to secure at least 70% & 60 % in aggregate for Commerce & Humanities respectively in class-X Board exam 2025-26 to be conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE (Odisha)/ Any State Board can apply.

- Declaration of the Result of Aptitude Test: **20.01.2026**.
- Schedule of Provisional Admission: **22.01.2026 to 05.02.2026** on all working days (Details of Admission procedure will be notified on the date of declaration of result).
- Provisional Admission shall be allowed purely on merit of Aptitude Test. However admission will be confirmed after declaration of respective Board Examination result and securing desired % of Mark.

- Commerce & Humanities**:- The candidate expecting to secure at least 70 % & 60 % in aggregate for Commerce & Humanities respectively in Class X Board Exam 2025-26 to be conducted by CBSE/ICSE/BSE. (Odisha)/Any state Board can apply.

## Procedure for admission to Class-XI (2026)

- He/She can take admission form from the school counter on payment of Rs.1000/- and deposit the duly filled- up form in school latest by 1 p.m. on **15 January 2026 (Thursday)**.
- Incomplete forms in any respect will be rejected.
- Money receipt of the admission form must be deposited along with the admission form.
- A photo copy of the Admit Card of the Board Exam 2025-26 will be submitted at the time of provisional admission.
- The candidates can register online through the school website [www.davrkl.org](http://www.davrkl.org). Please go through the process of online registration and the information sheet carefully before filling up the form.
  - Arrange the softcopy of the photographs of the candidate, father and mother in JPG file less than 1MB each.
  - Open the website [www.davrkl.org](http://www.davrkl.org) and click on Online Admission Link for Std. XI (Session 2026 – 27). Enter parent's email-id and mobile no. and press GENERATE CODE button. A password will be sent to the above email- id & mobile no. In LOGIN INFORMATION screen, enter the email-id and password and click on PROCEED button to go to next page. Enter the information asked for. Click the checkbox for the Declaration and click on Submit button.
  - After final submission of the registration form, the payment gateway will open and after paying a non refundable registration charge of Rs.1000/- successfully, take the print out of the registration form and submit to the school on the date of Aptitude Test.
- The list of eligible candidates for Aptitude Test will be available on our school website ([www.davrkl.org](http://www.davrkl.org)) at 4.00 p.m. on **16 January 2026 (Friday)**. Serial Number allotted in the list will be treated as the Roll No. for the Aptitude Test.
- The Aptitude Test will be held on **18 January 2026 (Sunday)** from 10.30a.m. to 12.30p.m. for Science Commerce & Humanities. Candidates are required to report at the venue 30 mins. before the commencement of the test.
- Candidates must bring their Aptitude Test Admit cards for identity proof and the hard copy of registration form duly signed by parents.(In case of online submission of form.).

## Details of the Aptitude Test:

- The test will be of 2 hour duration.
- The test is of **200** marks with **100** questions for Science, Commerce & Humanities.
- The questions will be MCQ type in OMR mode.
